## \$25 Rebate Offered in Specific Areas

If you live in the City of Lima, Village of Elida, or American, Bath, Perry, or Shawnee Townships, you are eligible for a rebate. This is a \$25 rebate per barrel, two per household per year. The form is on line at www.allenswcd.com. The rebate is restricted to these areas because they are in a USEPA mandated urban stormwater area, and these entities are funding their respective rebates.
